

How To Participate In The 2017 Sanders County Fair

Open Class Exhibit Entries: All Open Class Exhibit entries, including livestock and poultry & rabbits, must be pre-registered in order to enter the 2017 fair. There are no exceptions to this rule. If you fail to pre-register your entry, you will not be allowed to exhibit the entry.

Exhibits for judging: are to be taken to each Division between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. Arts, Crafts & Photography and Home Sewing & Needlecraft exhibits are to be entered on Monday, August 28, 2017. Culinary Arts, Floriculture and Horticulture exhibits are entered on Wednesday, August 30, 2017. *Livestock and Poultry & Rabbits exhibits are to be entered on Wednesday, August 30, 2017, between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m.* Exhibits may not be removed until after 6:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 3, 2017. Early removal of exhibits shall cause the forfeiture of any awards and/or premiums, and the entrant shall be barred from entering exhibits the following year. Where applicable, enter exhibits in the correct category that applies to you. In the case of any complaint against an exhibitor, Fair Management reserves the right to call for affidavits to satisfy a challenge. Each exhibitor can register only one entry per lot. Entries are accepted for published lots only.

Open Class Horse Show: Sponsored by Lazy AC Quarter Horses begins at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, September 2, 2017 in the horse arena. Entries in the Open Class Horse Show must be pre-registered. Entries will close at 8:30 on Saturday, September 2, 2017. Follow all the rules as listed in the Exhibitor's Handbook as they apply to the Open Class Horse Show.
