

Vendor Space at the 2017 Sanders County Fair

This information does not apply to food vendors.

Individuals and companies, both for-profit and non-profit, which participated in the 2016 Sanders County Fair, are provided a "Commercial or Non-Profit Vendor Space Reservation Form" to facilitate your participation in the 2017 fair. A map of the Vendor's Midway (not to scale) is included and depicts the available vendor spaces. Additional information about the Sanders County Fair is available on the fair's website at www.sanderscountyfair.com.

The space assigned to you is highlighted on the vendor's midway map. **Please complete the space reservation form in its entirety, SPECIFYING EXACTLY WHAT PRODUCTS YOUR WILL BE SELLING. Return the completed form, with payment in full, no later than May 15, 2017. Spaces not paid for at that time will be released to other vendors on our waiting list; there are NO exceptions to this Fair Commission rule.** Vendors may cancel their space reservation and receive a full refund up to July 24th. If you cancel after that date, there will be no refund issued.

Gate fees: If the Fair Commission implements a gate fee for the 2017 fair, each vendor will be provided one gate pass for each day of the fair. If more than one vendor uses the vendor space, those vendors will have to purchase a gate and parking pass.

Parking fees: If your vehicle will fit within your leased space, and stays parked for the duration of the fair, there is no parking fee. However, if you have a second vehicle, or don't remain permanently parked, you will be assessed a daily parking fee or you may purchase a weekly parking permit which covers the entire week of the fair. The fair runs from Monday, August 31st through Sunday, September 6th. **Vendors are required to be set-up no later than 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, August 30th.** You may set-up prior to the 30th if you desire. Arena events begin on Thursday, August 31st. Prior to that time, most activities involve open class and 4-H entries being brought to the fairgrounds, displayed and judged. The carnival will be set-up by Wednesday and will begin operations on Thursday, August 31st. **Please be advised that there are no dogs allowed on the midways!!!**

Due to the large crowds on Sunday, tear down and departure is not permitted for those vendors along the main fire lanes. **Those vendors on the Vendor's Midway who have access to the vendor gate, may depart after 6:00 p.m. on Sunday if they do not venture onto any fire lane.**

The Sanders County Fair provides roaming security patrols throughout the night, but does not guarantee the security of your vendor space or its contents. Safeguarding your product is your responsibility.

Weapons (guns, knives, etc.) and products of an illegal, immoral or pornographic nature are prohibited, as is silly string or fake cigarettes. This is a family-oriented fair and such products are not welcome. Please abide by these guidelines.
