Waste	Disposal Options
Adhesives, Contact Cements, Roofing Tar	If solid put in trash, if liquid, harden and put in trash.
Alkaline Batteries	Throw in trash.
Antifreeze	Firestone, 3075 Stockyard Rd., 543-7128. Max. 2 gals; Napa, 1136 Strand 543-6676 Max. 5 gals.; HHW Event (Sept).
Asbestos	Republic Services 542-3157. Call to make arrangements (fee) .
Car Batteries	Republic Services (Allied) Recycling, 3207 W. Broadway (543-3157); Batteries Plus 2100 Stephens (829-0634); Standard Batteries 3110 W. Broadway (542-1212).
Chlorinated Solvents	HHW Event (September) (fee) .
Electronic Waste: (computers, monitors, cell phones TV's)	Best Buy(\$25/TV), P.E.T.E.S (\$31/TV) Staples & Opportunity E-Cycling accept most e-waste for free (call for details); or check with computer manufacturers for details on their recycling programs.
Fluorescent Bulbs	Ace Hardware, Home Depot & Lowes accept compact fluorescent bulbs – no charge (no tubes) ; P.E.T.E.S. (Palmer Electric), 2407 Harve (543-3086) (fee) ; HHW Event (Sept.) – tubes only (up to 6) .
Fuel (bad)	HHW Event (September): up to 15 gallons.
Latex Paint (is non-hazardous)	Give to someone, solidify using an absorbent such as cat litter, (very small amounts allow it to dry in a well-ventilated area, or paint a board). Once solid put in trash. Cans at least ¾ full of good latex, <10 yrs old, never frozen can be taken to Home Resource (Call first: 541-8300) .
Motor Oil (used)	Republic Services (543-3157) curbside program (leave out in a clear-plastic container, 2-gals/wk.; or take to office if you have auto truck service) Most quick-lube centers will take it but call first, (See list on back →) .
Oil-Based Paint	Give to someone, very small amounts solidify as described above, or bring to HHW Event (September).
PCBs or PCB Ballasts	HHW Event (September – fee).
Pesticides/Herbicides	Give to someone who can use it; HHW Event (Sept. – fee).
Photographic Chemicals (Not-Used)	Sewer if connected to treatment plant, otherwise contact Sherri Kenyon, MWWTP (552-6606).
Photographic Chemicals (Used)	HHW Event (September – fee).
Rechargeable Batteries	Ace, Lowes, Home Depot, Sears, Radio Shack and many others.
Spray Paint	Spray on cardboard if just a little left, then throw can away; give to someone who can use it; if unable to empty bring to Haz Waste Days (September).
Strong Acids (Nitric, Hydrochloric, Sulfuric)	HHW Event (September – fee).
Thinners/Non-Chlorinated Solvents/Mineral Spirits	Give to someone if good, if used HHW Event (September).
Weak Acids (Muriatic, Phosphoric)	Sewer, flush with lots of water.
