

NOTICE OF CLOSE OF REGULAR VOTER REGISTRATION AND OPTION FOR LATE REGISTRATION

Notice is hereby given by the undersigned Election Administrator, acting in and for the Clerk of Hot Springs School District No. 14J, Noxon School District No. 10, Plains Public School District No. 1, and Trout Creek School District No. 6, and on behalf of the District Clerks/Election Administrators for Dixon School District No. 9 and Thompson Falls School District No. 2, Sanders County, State of Montana that regular registration for the Annual School Election to be held on Tuesday, May 2, 2017, will close at 5:00 pm on Monday, April 3, 2017.

Note: If you miss this regular registration deadline, you may still register for the election by showing up at the County Election Office up to and including on Election Day. Between noon and the close of business on the day before Election Day, you can complete and submit a voter registration card, but you will need to return to the County Election Office on Election Day to pick up and vote a ballot.

All active and inactive electors of the above-mentioned school districts are entitled to vote at said election.

Ballots will be automatically mailed to active electors only. If you are a registered voter and do not receive a ballot, contact the County Election Office to update your information as necessary and receive a ballot.

Persons who wish to register and who are not presently registered may do so by requesting a form for registration by mail, or by appearing at the County Election Office. If you have moved, please update your registration information by filling out a new voter registration form and submitting it to the County Election Office. Late registration is only available through the County Election Office, and not the School District.
