Employee Health

Your operation is required to conduct health assessments for all employees at the beginning of each shift. Health assessment means temperature checks and/or symptom screening.

Cleaning and Disinfection

- A. A specific cleaning and disinfection plan must be implemented, and employees must be trained in proper sanitation practices.

- B. Common surfaces should be disinfected at a frequency that relates to patron volume, but at least every 4 hours. This includes frequently touched surfaces such as vending machines, tables, light switches, doorknobs, countertops, handles, desks, phones, keyboards, toilets, faucets, sinks, etc.

- C. Disinfection chemicals must be EPA-registered as effective at killing human coronavirus.

- D. Follow CDC guidelines for cleaning and disinfecting.

Social/Physical Distancing

Every operation is required to practice social/physical distancing. This means a minimum of 6 feet between non-congregate individuals.

- E. Employers must use social distancing and protective equipment to ensure 6-feet of distance between employees and customers (greeting policy, plexiglass barrier, cloth face coverings, etc.)

- F. If customers wait in line, non-household customers are to remain physically distanced.

- G. Waiting areas where physical distancing cannot be maintained must be closed.

- H. Physical distancing of 6 feet must be maintained between non-congregate customers.
Physical distancing strategies may include:
- a. Reducing normal capacity.
 - b. Reducing seating capacity in service and waiting areas.
 - c. Use of an employee(s) to manage waiting areas and waiting lines.
 - d. Use of a system that reduce contact time between customers and employees.
