Per 7-33-2106. Details relating to board of trustees of fire district — election — (4) An elector, as defined in 13-1-101, who resides in the district or any holder of title to lands within the district who presents a proof of payment of taxes on the lands at the polling place is eligible to vote in the election.

13-1-101. Definitions. As used in this title, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, the following definitions apply: (1) "Active elector" means an elector whose name has not been placed on the inactive list due to failure to respond to confirmation notices pursuant to 13-2-220 or 13-19-313.
