F-3. ROAD CONSTRUCTION GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS AND INSPECTION REQUIREMENTS

General Specifications

- 1. All work shall comply with the provisions of Section VI-G. Streets and Roads of the Sanders County Subdivision Regulations
- 2. All work shall meet the provisions of the latest edition of the Montana Public Works Standard Specifications (MPWSS)
- 3. Clear and grub to width necessary to construct typical road sections (See F-1 and F-2)
- 4. Subgrade:
 - a. Free of all topsoil, vegetation, roots, stumps, organic matter, frozen material, refuse, construction debris or other man-made items within top 12" of subgrade
 - b. Shape and compact subgrade surface
 - c. Proof roll subgrade prior to placement of base
- 5. Base:
 - a. Minimum of 12" of 3" minus "Pit Run" Gravel
 - b. Shape for minimum 2% cross slope and compact base
- 6. Surface Course Gravel
 - a. Minimum of 3" of 1 1/2" minus Base Gravel as surface course
 - b. Uniform thickness across width of surface
 - c. Shape for minimum 2% cross-slope for surface drainage and compact
- 7. Surface Course Asphalt
 - a. Minimum of 3" of 1 1/2" minus Base Gravel placed over base
 - b. Minimum of 2" of Hot Mix Asphalt Pavement as surface course
 - c. Uniform thickness across width of surface
 - d. Shape for minimum 2% cross-slope for surface drainage and compact

Inspection Requirements

All construction shall be inspected by the County District Road Foreman at the following stages.

- A. Pre-Construction
- B. Clearing and Grubbing: Subgrade shall be proof rolled in presence of Road Foreman prior to placement of base material
- C. Base material
- A. Final Acceptance: After completion of surface course
